| Able to remain dry for several hours |
| Able to follow simple (1 and 2 step) commands |
| Able to communicate the need to use the potty |
| Eagerness to please |
| Desire for independence and control of bladder/bowel |
| General interest in the bathroom |
| Tells you that they need to go or asks for a diaper change |
| Shows discomfort when the diaper is wet or dirty |
